

NAME

nop – pretty-print graph file

SYNOPSIS

nop [**-p?**] [*files*]

DESCRIPTION

nop reads a stream of graphs and prints each in pretty-printed (canonical) format on stdout. If no *files* are given, it reads from stdin.

OPTIONS

The following options are supported:

- p** Produce no output - just check the input for valid DOT.
- ?** Print usage information.

EXIT STATUS

If any errors occurred while processing any input, such as a file not found or a file containing illegal DOT, **EXIT_FAILURE** is returned. Otherwise **EXIT_SUCCESS** is returned.
